Case Study

Shoreline, Folkestone

With panoramic views of the English Channel and a sparkling facade that mimics rippling waves, Shoreline in Folkestone is a showstopping development.

The scheme is the first part of a total regeneration of the Folkestone seafront and provides 84 new homes including 60 apartments, 20 townhouses and four duplexes, each with expansive sea views.

Brickability were initially contacted by local contractors Jenner (Contractors) Ltd, who asked them to find a durable brick that was low-maintenance and able to withstand the coastal elements. Discussions continued with the architects at ACME and the contractors until the Glazed White brick from our exclusive range was selected.

To help the project achieve its complex geometry and stunning finish, Brickability supplied over 630,000 Glazed White bricks in 24 different special shapes - each created to enhance the feeling of texture and movement within this unique facade.

Spinners Grange

At the entrance of Blockley village in Gloucestershire lies Spinners Grange, an attractive development that combines contemporary living with traditional country architecture. Developed by Cameron Homes and designed by Tyak architects, the 23 homes have all been constructed using traditional materials and production techniques.


A stroll through the village of Blockley reveals an abundance of buff-coloured Cotswold limestone stonework, therefore natural, local stone was an obvious choice for the Spinners Grange development.

Sawn, split and tumbled building stone was selected for each of the properties, accompanied by decorative stone dressings including quoins and corbels. Natural stone was also chosen for the heads and cills, providing a textural difference to the facade, while maintaining consistency with buildings in the local area.

The team at Brickability worked closely with the architects and the client to provide the range of natural stone products to the project, always considering the use of local materials and trades.
